- 2. Understanding and supporting the Board governance concept and Board policies.
- 3. Being knowledgeable concerning the District Means for accomplishing its Ends such as organization, facilities, instructional programs, budget, and key processes.
- 4. Being familiar with major district, state, and national issues affecting the School District.
- 5. Engaging in Board and self-development activities designed to promote Board effectiveness through attendance at Board association meetings.
- 6. Being aware of the local school environment.
- 7. Representing the District to the community.
- 8. Representing the community to the District.
- 9. Being aware of legislative issues.
