- 1. To provide information, answer questions, and provide solutions/resolutions at the lowest possible level;
- 2. To provide students, parents, and staff with a clear view of where initial contacts are to be made regarding important areas within schools and District; and,
- 3. To identify the positions/groups to which appeals may be made.

The table/chart is arranged as follows:

Key areas identified by the school/District

M Initial Contacts

The first contact to be made for each area listed by a student/parent.

Appeal Levels

The levels of appeal that may be made.
